Kunsthaus Zürich extends Christian Marclay's 'The Clock' until 9 September

Owing to the high level of visitor interest, the Christian Marclay video presentation 'The Clock' is being extended by a week. The masterpiece – an award winner at the Venice Biennale – can now be seen in the Kunsthaus Zürich until 9 September.

To date, 2,700 people have viewed at least part of the 24-hour work in the Kunsthaus. The Kunsthaus Zürich has therefore decided to extend its run by one week, until 9 September 2012. This Friday, 31 August, there is a last chance to see the work in its entirety, with access throughout the night.

Comfortable sofas provide seating for 45 people at a time, and a limited number of standing places are also available. Owing to space restrictions, we regret it is not possible to accommodate groups.

'The Clock' is a work in co-ownership of the Kunsthaus Zürich and Luma Foundation.
